

For Waterous, that means Made in the USA; cast, machined, assembled, and tested. This is Waterous' commitment to the fire service. Made vs. Assembled in the USA

At Waterous, we talk a lot about being Made in the USA. Waterous is Made in the USA. But what does it mean to actually be 'Made in the USA' verses 'Assembled in the USA'?

Requirement for 'Made in USA' - Product advertised as Made in USA must be 'all or virtually all' made in the U.S. All or virtually all means that all significant parts and processing that go into the product must be of U.S. origin. That is, the product should contain no — or negligible foreign content. The policy goes on to clarify that a 'product that is all or virtually all made in the United States will ordinarily be one in which all significant parts and processing that go into the product are of U.S. origin.



Requirements for 'Assembled in USA' - Product that includes foreign components may be called 'Assembled in USA' without qualification when its principal assembly takes place in the U.S. and the assembly is substantial. For the 'assembly' claim to be valid, the product's last 'substantial transformation' also should have occurred in the U.S.

THE ANATOMY OF A WELL-BUILT FIRE PUMP


CSU Single Stage Pump

Flame Plating – A water pump is always at the mercy of its water supply. Sand and other debris in the water is the number one cause of water pump wear. That's why we designed our flame-plated impellers with particles of tungsten carbide. These particles create an ultra hard surface on the impeller that is more resistant to abrasion from debris. Our flame-plated impeller can last five times longer than a non-flame-plated impeller.

Wear Ring - A pump's wear rings ensure your pump maintains optimal performance. Since the 1970s, Waterous has manufactured labyrinth reverse flow wear rings. The labyrinth track helps reduce flow by forcing water to pivot before flowing back into the eye of the impeller. This prevents water from getting trapped in the pump, ultimately making the impeller more efficient.


Separable Impeller Shaft

- Downtime is detrimental to a fire apparatus. A pump containing a separable impeller shaft can help prevent unwanted downtime. If a problem arises, fire brigades can remove the shaft without disassembling the entire pump. This process can slash both downtime and maintenance costs.



Greater Than the Sum of its Parts

Waterous has the parts in stock and in-house. This means if you need a new part, it will get to you fast, usually within 24 hours. In addition, parts are available for a minimum of twenty (20) years from the date of manufacture of your fire pump or accessory.

FLAME-PLATED IMPELLERS

The heart of the fire pump is the impeller. Waterous impellers are vacuum cast bronze, hydraulically, and mechanically balanced for vibration-free operation. Waterous' available tungsten carbide flame plating adds up to 5x the life expectancy of the hub of the impeller.







CHAIN DRIVE TRANSMISSION

The C20 Transmission provides the best In-Class power transfer. The silent chain drive provides no gear whining, provides positive shifting and requires less horsepower that will enhance the efficiency of the apparatus.





EASE OF MAINTENANCE

Separable Impeller Shaft

Allows you to remove the transmission while leaving the pump in the apparatus.

Preformed O-ring Gasket

Instead of paper gasket between pump body halves for better sealing and easier repair.

Sealed Outboard Bearings

Eliminates the maintenance at the outboard end of the pump.





STANDARD 7-YEAR WARRANTY

Waterous's new standard, seven-year parts warranty is designed to bring customers added assurance alongside the most reliable fire pumps on the market. The new Waterous warranty is an additional two years in length, making it the longest warranty offered in the fire pump industry.

The new warranty states that all pumps manufactured by Waterous will be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use and service for a period of seven years from the date the product is first placed in service, or seven and a half years from the date of shipment.

We said earlier we take pride in our products and that is why we don't buy our castings from overseas, machine nearly all our components in-house and employ a workforce that is dedicated to providing the quality products you deserve.

Supply chain issues are a problem in all industries. At Waterous, we minimize those problems by sourcing our castings and raw stock from foundries and companies inside the United States. We then machine castings and raw stock inside our South St. Paul factory so we are not waiting on the supply chain for our finished goods.

Waterous also maintains a large volume of repair parts in the event an apparatus goes out of service for needed repair.

While we can't promise that we may experience some supply chain issues in the future, we are less susceptible to those pressures by keeping our resources, machining and manufacturing inside the United States.
